NEW ZEALAND VINTAGE TOOL COLLECTORS' CLUB Inc.

CLUB POLICIES

1 - TOOL DISPLAYS AND EXHIBITIONS

Where an invitation or opportunity arises for the Club to participate in or provide a display, demonstration, or exhibition of any nature that is consistent with the Club's objects, the Club's policy is:-

- 1. Each request for the Club's involvement must be referred to the Committee for consideration.
- 2. Individual member(s) may not participate in or provide a display, demonstration, or exhibition of any nature in the name of the New Zealand Vintage Tool Collector's Club without the approval of the Committee.
- 3. The following matters will be included in the Committee's determination of the extent to which the Club will be involved in the proposed event.
 - a. Consistency with the Club's objectives.
 - b. The cost to the Club.
 - c. The potential income for the Club.
 - d. The availability of members for the event
 - e. The public relations benefits to the Club.

2 – APPRAISALS OF TOOLS OR COLLECTIONS OF TOOLS

Where the Club or a member or members of the Club at a Club activity or function have an opportunity or receive a request to appraise or provide an opinion on the value of a tool or collection of tools or the possible disposal of the tool or collection, the Club's policy is:-

- 1. All requests received from the public at such Club events are considered to be requests to the Club and not a request to an individual member(s).
- 2. Each request for appraisal will be completed in full on the Club's 'Request for Appraisal' application form and submitted to the Committee for consideration.
- 3. The Committee will review the application and delegate two members of the Club to view the tool(s) and promptly complete an appraisal and return it to the Committee for despatch to the enquirer.

3 - SALES OF TOOLS OR COLLECTIONS OF TOOLS BY THE NZVTCC

Where the Club has been donated tools or received tools for disposal by auction, the Club's policy is :-

- 1. In the event that tools or a collection of tools has been donated to the NZVTCC, the donor shall complete and sign a 'discharge' relinquishing all rights of ownership to the tool or collection of tools.
- 2. Where the Club has been requested to auction tools or a collection of tools, the vendor shall complete an 'authority to auction' accepting the Club's 'Terms and Conditions of Auction' which will include a 'discharge of ownership' to the goods being auctioned.
- 3. Purchasers of goods sold by auction by the Club shall pay a buyer's premium determined by the Committee.
